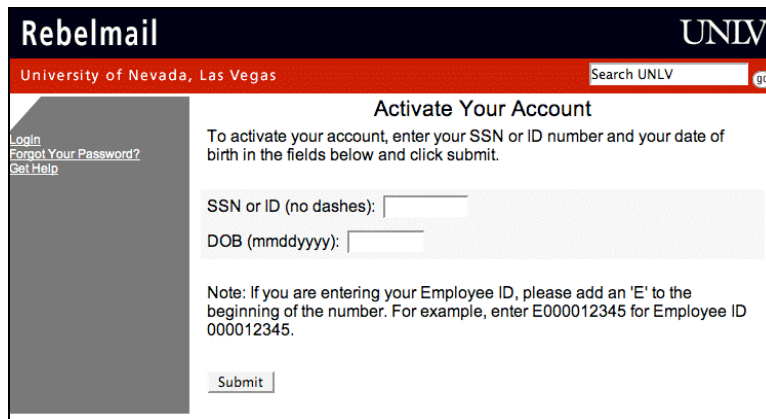

Steps for Automatically Forwarding Rebel Mail to Another Email Account (like Interact)

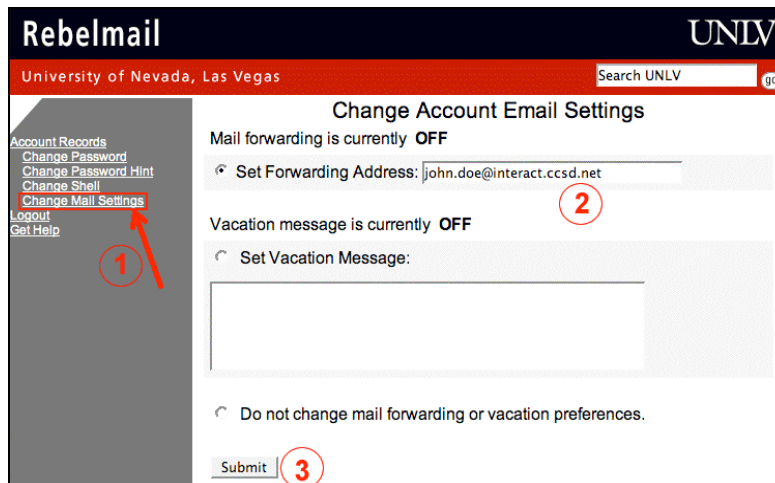
1. Go to <http://rebelmail.unlv.edu> and select *Activate Now*



2. Complete the form to activate your account and **submit**.
